<p>Important behaviors and determinants to address</p>	<p>Behaviors: Frequency of sexual intercourse, Correct and consistent use of condoms</p> <p>Determinants: Knowledge about sexuality, HIV, STIs, condoms, and contraception; Attitudes about HIV, STIs, and pregnancy, and possible consequences; Skills relevant to HIV, STIs, and pregnancy, and possible consequences</p>
<p>What's already getting attention and resources?</p>	<p>General health care; sexual and reproductive health care; substance abuse; depression and isolation</p>
<p>What priorities do we think still need attention?</p>	<p>General pregnancy, STI, and HIV prevention addressing above behaviors and determinants</p>
<p>What can we address with our resources, time and budget?</p>	<p>Behaviors: Frequency of sexual intercourse, Correct and consistent use of condoms</p> <p>Determinants: Knowledge about sexuality, HIV, STIs, condoms, and contraception; Attitudes about HIV, STIs, and pregnancy, and possible consequences; Skills relevant to HIV, STIs, and pregnancy, and possible consequences</p>
<p>What can we change (and measure?)</p>	<p>Change in knowledge, attitude, and skill</p>
<p>What actions can we take that will have the greatest impact?</p>	<p>Integrating an STI, HIV, and pregnancy prevention curriculum that addresses these behaviors and determinants, into our existing substance abuse program</p>
<p>Who will benefit from these actions?</p>	<p>Fayetteville High School youth who participate in the program</p>
